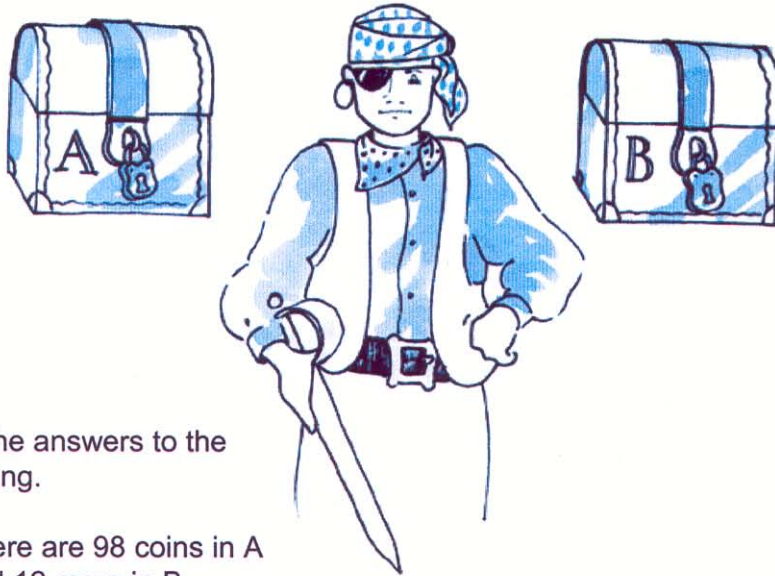


Pirate's gold

The following questions deal with two chests filled with gold coins. The chests are referred to as A and B.



Find the answers to the following.

1. There are 98 coins in A and 12 more in B.
How many are in B?
2. In A there are 104 and in B there are 26 less.
How many are in B?
3. There are 83 in A. This is 17 more than in B.
How many are in B?
4. In A there are 76. This is 25 less than in B.
How many are in B?
5. In A there are 47 and in B 38.
How many are in A and B together?
6. In A and B there are 178 in total. Both contain the same amount.
How many coins are in each chest?
7. There are 68 in A, exactly half the amount in B.
How many coins are in B?
